The parents of Marlene Methelis, Marjorie and Alan Methelis have established a scholarship in loving memory of their daughter. Marlene tragically lost her life in an automobile accident in August of 1993. As a student enrolled at Plantation High School, Marlene, 16, was a talented young woman whose interests focused on the Fine Arts. This award, in Marlene's memory, is being offered to Broward County graduating seniors whose post-secondary plans include furthering their education in the areas of Fine Arts: photography, sculpting, ceramics, fashion design, painting and drawing.

- 1. Applicants must meet the following criteria:
- 2. Must pursue career in the Fine Arts. No performing arts, dance, film, architecture, or computer graphics. Consideration will be given to Fine Arts Education.
- 3. Submit proof of acceptance to an accredited college, university, community college, institute of art, or vocational-technical center.
- 4. Submit one letter of recommendation, preferably from a teacher of Fine Art, and a sample of your work, maximum of three. Original artwork preferred, high quality color copies will be accepted. No slides will be accepted. Please designate the art medium on each piece submitted. <u>High photo quality color copies must be at least 8" X 10" or larger.</u>
- 5. Have a cumulative G.P.A. of 2.5 or above (Most recent unofficial transcript required).
- 6. Include in the application a short essay indicating why you would like to receive this scholarship and during selection, why you feel you would be the best candidate to be selected.

Complete the application and submit by 4:00 PM. on April 2, 2018.
