

Born and raised in Fort Lauderdale, a student of Broward County Public Schools, Mr. Russell currently serves as Sr. Director of Current Affairs for the Miami Dolphins.

Mr. Russell is a graduate of the University of Miami with a Bachelor's Degree in criminology and broadcasting communications, along with a minor in English. While in college, Russell also realized the importance of giving back to the community, most importantly his community. During these years, he vowed to personally make a difference.

Before joining the Miami Dolphins organization, Mr. Russell excelled in sports as a professional athlete, playing in the NFL. During his NFL career, Russell played the linebacker position for the Washington Redskins, the Miami Dolphins and the Atlanta Falcons. Due to an injury, he decided to retire from professional football in November 2004.

Mr. Russell and his mother, Corliss Ann Russell, a retired 30+ year teacher of Lauderhill Middle School, began The Russell Life Skills and Reading Foundation, Inc. The Foundation is a 501(c) (3) nonprofit organization that was formed to "tackle" the high illiteracy rate of inner city youth and the lack of educational resources available to them. Its mission is, "Opening Books to Open Doors," with the overall goal of eradicating illiteracy among inner city youth and empowering, inspiring and encouraging at-risk youth to become successful citizens.

Through his Foundation's multi-faceted after-school program, Russell continues to demonstrate to children that statistics are just what they are – numbers and figures on a piece of paper. The only way to achieve anything is through literacy. For Twan, it is truly a testament that opening books does open doors.






She attended Florida State University receiving a Bachelor's of Science Degree in English Education. Dr. Wanza received a Master of
