

#### **OLAYEMI AWOFADEJU**

A proud graduate of Plantation High School Class of 1995, Olayemi Awofadeju is principal of South Broward High School. A 15-year public education veteran, she is widely known for her passion and commitment to all students, regardless of their ethnic or socioeconomic status. It has always been her desire to serve as an educator. She believes that being a school leader is a great responsibility, but also a privilege, as it is one of the most important jobs in America today.

The ability to influence youth and inspire them to work to achieve their dreams, no matter their circumstance is a personal matter

for Olayemi because it was her teachers who inspired her to hold herself to high expectations and push herself when she faced adversity in her childhood. It was her aunt and high school guidance counselor both alumni of Florida A&M University, who encouraged her to begin her postsecondary schooling there. She earned both her undergraduate and graduate degrees at Florida A&M and then went on to earn additional certifications at Florida State University. Olayemi says, "As educators, we cast our nets to reach all that we can, and it is my intention to cast the widest net possible, to intentionally and positively impact each student each day."

Although Olayemi started at very humble beginnings, her mother emphasized that education was the only way to secure a good future as it offers more opportunities.

As a mother herself she is reminded daily that "only a solid educational foundation will ensure that any child will be able to take advantage of all opportunities given to them in this great nation."

As principal of South Broward High School, she has successfully implemented initiatives that have enhanced faculty morale and student achievement, including enrollment and graduation rates which increased higher than they've been in a decade.







**RODERICK "ROCKY" GILLIS** 



Roderick "Rocky" Gillis was a football star as a student at Pompano Beach High School. Upon graduating with honors in 1978, he attended Iowa State University on a football scholarship. Rocky earned a degree in small business management and was also a member of Army ROTC. He was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant as part of the early commissioning program in the summer of 1983 while attending ROTC Advanced Camp at the Fort Lewis military base in Tacoma, Washington. He graduated from Armor Officer School at Fort Knox, Kentucky where he was trained as a tank commander. He received an Honorable Discharge from the U.S. Army in 1988.

For the last 14 years he has been the County Athletic Director for Broward County Public Schools. One of five children in the

Gillis family, the native Floridian was educated in the Broward County School System, attending Sanders Park Elementary, Pompano Beach Elementary, Pompano Beach Middle and Pompano Beach High School.

Rocky was very involved in the City of Pompano Beach Parks and Recreation programs during his adolescence and young adult life participating in City of Pompano Beach football, basketball and baseball recreation programs as well as several other leagues provided by local organizations. He served as a coach for several of the City of Pompano Beach Parks and Recreation programs during high school.

When he returned home from college, he worked for Nabisco and continued to be a youth sports coach. It was there that he found his calling to work with young people and prepare them for their futures in this ever-changing society. So he switched careers and became a teacher. He started as a substitute teacher in January 1990 and began teaching mathematics full-time at Blanche Ely High School in spring of 1991 and at Pompano Beach High School from 1998 to 2003 before leaving to become County Athletic Director.

Rocky attends and is member of Bethel A.M.E. He currently serves on the Steward and Media Ministries for his church.



When not serving her community, Nancy enjoys golf, photography, hiking, fishing, boating, skiing, stand-up paddle boarding and scuba diving.







# COMMUNITY ACHIEVEMENT AWARD



#### **GEORGE LEMIEUX**

George LeMieux, a graduate of the Coral Springs High School Class of 1987, serves as the chairman of the board of Gunster law firm. He focuses his practice on resolving business, and governmental disputes, and advising CEOs and C-suite executives on business, law and government from a local, state and national perspective.

He advocates for clients before state and federal trial and appellate courts, as well as governmental agencies and regulatory bodies. He defends clients in enforcement matters brought by state attorneys general, advocates for clients in administrative law proceedings including bid protests, and counsels governmental bodies on

public records and public meeting requirements. Because of his breadth of legal experience, his practice includes professional liability defense. He has successfully litigated intellectual property and business disputes to verdict. George also has experience leading internal investigations for corporate clients at the direction of management and boards of directors.

George served as Florida's 34th United States Senator in the 111th Congress. In the United States Senate, he served on the Commerce, Science and Transportation Committee, the Armed Services Committee, and the Special Committee on Aging. He successfully passed legislation on health care fraud, export promotion, rating agency reform, small business promotion, as well as a treaty resolution on tactical nuclear weapons.

George served as Florida's deputy attorney general overseeing more than 400 attorneys and appearing before appellate courts on behalf of the state of Florida, including the United States Supreme Court. George also served as the governor's chief of staff overseeing all state agencies and operations. In that role, he negotiated a gaming compact with the Seminole Tribe of Florida. He is the founder of the LeMieux Center for Public Policy at Palm Beach Atlantic University.
