



Keith is active in many South Florida community organizations and currently serves as a Broward Workshop Board Trustee, a Greater Fort Lauderdale Alliance CEO Council member, and is a Museum of Discovery & Science Board Member. A passionate Gator, he serves on the University of Florida Foundation Board as Life Member and past board chair.

Founding the Kevin Koenig Memorial Covenant House Cup Golf Tournament, now in its 21st year, is one of the highlights of Keith's charitable support. The tournament has raised more than \$1.5 million to help runaway, homeless and at-risk youth.



Not many people can say they still walk the halls of their alma mater 45 years after graduating. Patrick McQuaid does just that every day as Athletic Director, Head Baseball Coach and Department Head of Physical Education at Nova High School.

Patrick combined his passion for sports and mentoring students when he returned in 1974 to coach the Nova High baseball team.

Under his guidance, 33 student athletes have been drafted by professional baseball teams and five players have joined the major leagues. He's led the Titans to 20 District Championships, five final four appearances, two State Championships and a National Championship. To honor the coach's decades of exceptional dedication and service to Nova High, the baseball field was named the "Pat McQuaid Field."

Patrick says, "Teaching the universal values of trust, respect, service, responsibility, sacrifice hard work and integrity has always been my mission. Along the way, I've worked to build a program with tradition that helps young men achieve their athletic dreams. I am proud to see so many of these young men grow up, succeed in business and give back to the community."

In addition to Broward Education Foundation Hall of Fame, Pat has been inducted into the Broward County Sports Hall of Fame, Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSAA) Hall of Fame and Florida Athletic Coaches Association Hall of Fame. He is a two-time FHSAA Baseball Coach of the Year and is also a past FHSAA Football Coach of the Year.





Max began his career as an Education Counselor for the Seminole Agency of the Bureau of Indian Affairs. He then became an Education Director for the Seminole Tribe of Florida before returning to the Bureau of Indian Affairs as an Administrative Officer. For the next 25 years he served as a Hollywood Councilman to the Seminole Tribe of Florida. In 2008, Max notably was involved with the Tribe's acquisition of Hard Rock International for \$974 million.

Among the organizations Max has been involved with include Winterfest Boat Parade, Florida Governor's Council on Indian Affairs, Seminole Tribe of Florida Boys and Girls Club, Seminole Tribe of Florida Health, Boys and Girls Club of Broward County, Utah's Intermountain School and Ann Storck Center. He serves as a trustee for Pine Crest School and on the Constitution committee of the Seminole Tribe of Florida. He also donates his time to National Indian Boys and Girls Club, Pine Ridge Reservation Boys and Girls Club, Stranahan House, Women in Distress and Toys in the Sun Run.

In addition to Broward Education Foundation Hall of Fame, Max has been inducted into the Broward County Athletic Hall of Fame, Broward Community College Alumni Hall of Fame and Seminole Tribe of Florida Athletic Hall of Fame.

Max earned a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from University of Miami and is an avid Hurricanes fan.
