Today as founders of the non-profit Crockett Foundation, Inc., where Henri is president and Zack is vice president, this dynamic duo serves youth through educational programs with the mission to help build character, develop leaders and improve the community, one child at a time.

Together the brothers have created the annual Crockett Foundation Community Health Festival to bring families together as they prepare for the back-to-school season. The goal of the festival is to educate families on the importance of maintaining good health and to promote positive lifestyle choices.

Broward County School System staff helped motivate and inspire Zack to be who he is today. He was impacted by the daily motivation he received from teachers, administration and custodians who acknowledged his efforts to succeed and cared enough to pull him aside to offer words of wisdom if they noticed he was off track.

Henri credits the success of the person he is today to his high school principal James L. Jones who taught him the importance of accountability, sacrifice and character. Mr. Jones told him, "Son hold your head up and listen. Life is not fair and you're not always going to get the credit that you think you deserve. A Fellow of the prestigious Florida Bar Foundation since 2010, Juliette currently serves as president where she has also been a member of the executive committee since 2015. A 20 year volunteer with the Children's Diagnostic and Treatment Center, she currently serves as its board chairwoman. Additionally, she has served on the boards of Broward Legal Aid's For the Public Good, Unicorn Children's Foundation, the Center for Independent Living of Broward and PEER Center.

Throughout her legal career, Juliette has received many accolades including receiving the AV Preeminent rating by Martindale-Hubbell, a testament to the fact that her peers rank her at the highest level of professional excellence. She is a Top Fifty Women Lawyer, Top One Hundred Lawyer and is a Florida Super Lawyer.

A graduate of George Washington University, Juliette received her juris doctor from Nova Southeastern University School of Law.

She also is founder of the non-profit Females On A Mission, a positive mentoring program for teenage girls.

From 2008 to 2016, Patricia served on the Lauderdale Lakes City Commission and in 2011 was Vice Mayor. During those eight years she effected change, leading the effort to host the city's first ever Black History Parade and sponsoring a resolution to start a Youth Council Program.

One of Patricia's fondest high school memories was her membership in DECA (Distributive Education Clubs of America) because it gave her the opportunity to earn money while learning a skill. She firmly believes in the importance of investing in students today for tomorrow's benefit.

Active in the community, Patricia currently serves as a member of Broward League of Cities Leadership Development Committee and Neighborhood Stabilization and Housing Subcommittee. She has served as chair of the Lauderdale Lakes School Advisory Board, as a Lauderdale Lakes Planning and Zoning Board commissioner, as chair for the American Cancer Society's Relay for Life, as assistant secretary and treasurer for Florida Black Caucus of Local Elected Officials, Inc. (FBC-LEO.) Williams has also served two consecutive terms as chair of the Lauderdale Lakes CRA.

Patricia earned a Bachelor of Science and Master of Arts in Business Administration and a Master of Arts in Human Resources Development Management from University of Phoenix.

When Ralph was a senior at Western High School, where he graduated in 1995, two events altered Ralph's college path. His younger brother required emergency brain surgery, and two months later, Ralph suffered a major car accident resulting in significant injury, ending his dream of playing college athletics. He's thankful that Broward County Public Schools employs a BRACE Advisor at each high school dedicated to supporting students to access postsecondary options. His BRACE Advisor assured him that he was a student-athlete, student first and athlete second. When his future suddenly felt uncertain, his advisor helped him register for the SAT and ACT, apply for scholarships and gain acceptance into multiple universities.


Now Ralph is serving and inspiring students as his BRACE Advisor once did. He directs more than 500 school-based counselors and college advisors at more than 330 public, charter, alternative and adult schools, serving more than 270,000 students in grades K-adult. He founded, championed and led the implementation of Broward's local college access network, Bridge to Life (B2L), including more than 25 actively engaged community organizations, businesses, colleges and government organizations.

Aiello's professional involvement includes memberships in the American School Counselor Association (ASCA), Florida School Counselor Association (FSCA), Broward School Counselor Association (BSCA), National College Access Network (NCAN), Florida College Access Network (FCAN) and Naviance National Advisory Board.

Ralph has received the 2019 FCAN College Ready Innovator Award and 2018 FCAN Unsung Hero Award and was named the 2017 BSCA Administrator of the Year, 2017 FSCA Administrator/Advocate of the Year and 2017 FAFSA Challenge Recipient.

As a nationally recognized program coordinator and educator with experience developing talent through learning opportunities for students in a K-12 environment, Randall firmly believes in finding bliss through diversity and in turning that passion into a driving force of lifelong learning. This is his mission statement as an educator and a habit of mind he instills in all of his students.

Randall has a proven track record of bringing together schools, industry partners and community organizations that prepare high-need students for the current workforce. To address the minority gap in STEM careers, he partnered with a local software architect and together they designed and provided an authentic learning experience that empowered students with an in-depth knowledge of computer science. This partnership led to the formation of ReGenerate Tech, a not-for-profit organization.

Through this endeavor, Randall and his industry partners recruited volunteers who taught students and provided valuable feedback on their computer science solutions. This after-school program allowed students to hone their workforce skills leading them to real-world work experiences including student-led workshop facilitation, conference presentations, employment opportunities, paid internships and national recognition in computer science.

An active member of the International Society for Technology in Education, Randall has proudly shared his work at the National Staff Development Council Conference, Florida Educator Technology Conference, Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development's Conference, Florida Association for Staff Development and the International Society for Technology in Education.

Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School's new principal and the State of Florida's 2019 Principal of the Year Michelle Kefford attributes her love of inquiry to the incredible teachers she had as a teenager at her beloved alma mater.

A graduate of South Plantation High School in 1992, Michelle was previously principal of Charles W. Flanagan High School for eight years. Under her leadership, the school earned its first ever grade of "A" based on Florida's Accountability System and was recognized by then Governor Rick Scott for ranking in the top 10 percent of all high schools in Florida for improved reading performance and overall graduation rates. The school also was recognized for ranking in the top 20 percent for improved math performance.

As an advocate of the LGBTQ community, Michelle worked diligently to develop the current policies regarding the rights of transgender students in Broward County Public Schools and assisted other school districts with the development of their policies to ensure equity for transgender students.

One of the many highlights of Michelle's career was the launch of Kefford's Kids, a peer mentoring program designed to improve both the morale and academic achievement of students. The program was so successful that it is highlighted in a book published by Harvard Education Press.






