



In the 1960s, when Eric Jones, Jr.'s Attucks High School English teacher Henry Wilson refused to let him settle for mediocre grades or accept his fear of public speaking, it profoundly changed the trajectory of his life, paving the way for decades of Eric's future success.

After graduating and serving in Vietnam, Eric became a pastor, where he has served for more than 40 years. He also founded the City of West Park, Broward County's 31st municipality, where he was mayor for 15 years.

Koinonia Worship Center & Village, the church he founded after returning from service in the Vietnam War and is senior pastor, continues to provide services to the South Broward community such as feeding the hungry, mentoring youth, providing after-school and Saturday tutorial programs, economic empowerment education and even drug rehabilitation and counseling for those who need it.

A recipient of the Urban League of Broward County's Thurgood Marshall Advocacy Award, among many other honors and accolades, Eric has been continually active in professional, civic and community organizations focused on helping others find their own voice, including South Broward Ministerial Alliance, Florida Black Caucus of Local Elected Officials, Alliance for Action Council of Florida, Pastors' Recreational Educational and Strategy Sharing Coalition, Urban League of Broward County, 100 Men of Broward County and Carver Ranches MECCA, among others.

A graduate of Charron Williams Para-Medical College with a degree in biological sciences, Eric was also bestowed with an honorary Doctor of Divinity by St. Thomas Christian University.

Eric also attended what was then B.F. James Elementary School and Lanier Junior High School in Hallandale. Today it is the Lanier-James Education Center.

Eric urges others to mentor and volunteer in public schools, as well as vote for those who will invest in them to ensure that future generations will be properly equipped to become productive citizens.







Brett Htkinson

Moss Construction's South Florida President Brett Atkinson, who attended Nova Blanche Forman Elementary, Nova Middle, and Nova High School, was inspired by the lessons he learned as part of the Nova High School Titans baseball program. From their coach, Patrick McQuaid, he and his teammates learned valuable life lessons about trust, respect, service, responsibility, sacrifice, and integrity in ways that none of them will ever forget.

Using baseball as a tool to teach Brett and the other players about life, the value of teamwork, and hard work, Coach McQuaid helped him become an All-County baseball player and, in the process, prepared him for leadership as an adult, too.

Brett graduated from Nova High in 1989, graduated from the University of Florida with a Bachelor of Science in Building Construction and Building Technology, and became a general contractor. He has been active in the community, serving as a board member and former chair of Associated Builders and Contractors, a member of the Construction Association of South Florida and Construction Executives Association, and an executive committee member of the University of Florida Rinker School of Construction Management.

Throughout the year, Brett supports students in the classroom through the Moss Foundation, which annually organizes an employee-led back-to-school fundraiser and purchase of school supplies for underserved students in Broward County Public Schools, to help alleviate costs for clothes, shoes, backpacks, paper, and more.

Brett has never forgotten the indelible impact Coach McQuaid's "Field of Dreams" made on his life as a role model and mentor. To acknowledge his coach, the program, and that impact, he spearheaded a donation for Nova's baseball outfield wall, which he designed to give the existing complex the look and feel of a true stadium atmosphere. With support from Moss employees and subcontractors, Brett collected \$200,000 worth of materials and labor to complete the project.

When he was a student in Broward County Public Schools, State Representative Chip LaMarca's teachers had such a profound influence on his life, he can not only name his favorites but remains in contact with them to this day, especially with Dee Davis, his third-grade teacher at Floranada Elementary School.

As a music student, Chip learned from his band directors that practice and dedication were valuable habits to help him achieve his adult goals of a career in public service, where he has made a direct positive impact on public education, first as a Lighthouse Point City Commissioner, then as a Broward County Commissioner and now as a State Representative. He serves as Vice Chair of the Tourism, Infrastructure & Energy Subcommittee and is a member of the Education & Employment Committee, Early Learning & Elementary Education Subcommittee, Public Integrity & Elections Committee, Environment, Agriculture & Flooding Subcommittee, and Infrastructure & Tourism Appropriations Subcommittee. Active in the community, Chip has served in leadership roles for numerous education and child-centered charitable organizations, including Broward Children's Center, Special Olympics of Broward County, and Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, among others. He sits on numerous boards including the Greater Fort Lauderdale Alliance and Riverwalk Trust. Over the years Chip has received numerous honors and accolades including Florida Restaurant and Lodging Association Hospitality Ambassador of the Year and from the Florida Association of Counties, Presidential Advocate Award, Presidential Service Award, and the President's Commitment to Service Award.

Committed to promoting community involvement with Broward County Public School students, Chip participates in programs such as "Reading for the Record" and "Reading Pals," as well as volunteering in local public schools. Chip is proudest of the collaborations he has fostered with local business leaders and Northeast High School graduates to advocate for the school's reconstruction.

Stacy Ritter traces her lifetime of public service back to her two favorite Piper High School teachers with whom she still keeps in contact: Nancy Springer, who instilled in her a love of humanities and an appreciation for art, culture, and classical literature, and David Gordon, who inspired her to become a history major.

Broward County residents are substantially better off thanks to Stacy's lifelong love of people. Countless area residents remember her successfully rollerblading door to door to win her first Florida House of Representatives campaign. For the next eight years, her determined advocacy for Broward County resulted in securing millions of dollars of program funding for everything from education to transportation.

Later, during her successful 10 years as a Broward County Commissioner, Stacy led the monumental approval for construction to begin on the new south runway at Fort Lauderdale International Airport, as well as for the new downtown courthouse, both of which have positively impacted the community with generational growth and change.

With numerous awards, accolades, and leadership positions in various community and charitable organizations, Stacy today heads Broward County's tourism agency, Visit Florida, where she recently spearheaded the campaign, "Everyone Under the Sun," promoting our community as a welcoming and accommodating destination for all.

Stacy continues to be an advocate for public school teachers, urging decision-makers to properly fund them with supplies and pay them an appropriate wage commensurate with their important task of preparing students to function as adults in life. She has faith in letting teachers do their jobs and giving them the freedom to help students learn to think analytically "... just as my parents did when I was a student and as I did when my children were students."

Stacy graduated from Rollins College and then graduated from Nova Southeastern University's Shepard Broad College of Law.

Broward County Public Schools Director of Talent Acquisition & Operations Eric Chisem has a message for the world: Don't give up on your childhood. Stay childlike, because it's the time when all of us are the most forgiving. Embracing this feeling can help everyone feel more positive each day, he says.

Once a child statistic whose life could have easily gone astray, Eric lost his parents to drug abuse when he was only five years old. He was placed in several foster homes until his paternal grandfather took him in, only to later die when Eric was 12. From then on, Eric literally had no one to turn to except for the caring educators at Lauderhill Paul Turner Elementary and Lauderhill Middle School. Because his teachers believed in him, he knew he could make something out of his life by taking control of how he responded to challenges, rather than letting them overwhelm him.

During Eric's senior year at Dillard High School, he worked two jobs, one of which was in the Risk Management and Safety Department of Broward County Public Schools. After graduating in 1993, he devoted the next 30 years of his life to Broward County Public Schools, the only home he had ever known. While working his way up to his current role, Eric dedicated himself to helping children by mentoring, tutoring, and passing on his life lessons of positivity as a social media influencer with his trademarked #LearnedMan.





Wanda E. Haynes

When the City of Sunrise proclaimed "Wanda E. Haynes Day" in February 2022, it was because she literally changed the hearts and minds of her community, with children as the primary beneficiaries.

When Wanda, a veteran educator, answered the call in 2017 to turn around the failing Village Elementary School, she drew courage from her lifelong positive experiences. While a student at Nova Blanche Forman Elementary, a teacher noted that Wanda was profoundly deaf and alerted her parents. This life-changing discovery enabled her to get a hearing aid and help with coping strategies. She was never treated differently and developed a strong sense of personal pride and responsibility because she was held to the same high expectations as other students.

As the new principal of Village Elementary, Wanda worked to change the internal culture from one of grudging ordertaking to collaborative problem-solving, despite the lacking adequate operations and business support resources. She revamped the school's entire philosophical approach into one modeled on a Caribbean "house system" that incorporated the four principles of Kwanzaa: purpose, unity, self-determination, and creativity. Wanda hired new teachers more culturally similar to her predominantly Caribbean students and added incentives to encourage their good grades, regular attendance, and excellent behavior.

But just as Wanda and her staff had dramatically improved Village Elementary's overall performance, COVID hit. When the school partially re-opened in October 2020, fewer than 200 of nearly 600 students had returned to the campus, with a mere 75 trickling back by January 2021. Ultimately, Village Elementary recovered, and through hard work, Wanda, her team, and the teachers posted remarkable academic achievement gains despite the overwhelming challenges.

Wanda knows that, although the families at her school may not be blessed with financial wealth, they still want the best for their children. It's her lifetime goal to continue to be their champion.

Summarizing the enormity of Dr. Lisa Milenkovic's extraordinary career could fill pages listing her many accomplishments, initiatives, and national accolades, including awards from the National Science Foundation, U.S. Department of Education, and U.S. Department of Environmental Protection. As Broward County Public Schools science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) and Computer Science Curriculum Supervisor, she has brought national recognition to Broward's public schools from the White House, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, National Geographic and the National Basketball Association, among many others.

As a student at Coral Springs Middle School and Coral Springs High School, she excelled in algebra, calculus, physics, and even orchestra. But instead of working elsewhere, after earning her Ph.D. in Environmental Analytical Chemistry from Northeastern University, Lisa brought the world home to Broward County dedicating herself to teaching STEM and computer science. She has secured more than \$9 million in funds and donations, particularly to expand educational access for underrepresented groups.

Thanks to Lisa's efforts, Broward County Public Schools has become a national model for STEM and computer science instruction, such as the #BrowardCodes initiative she created. She also leads Broward's regional partnership for Code.org, among other district-wide initiatives, competitions, and challenges such as "CodeFests."

Lisa has been a trailblazer in environmental science education as well, inspiring and mobilizing students and teachers to take action to improve our environment through programs she created including the Annual Broward Youth Climate Summit, with speakers such as the renowned astrophysicist Dr. Neil deGrasse Tyson.

Believing opportunity should never be limited for anyone, whether students or school staff, Lisa never underestimates her students of any age, especially because she believes in teaching them the problem-solving value of computational and critical thinking, spatial reasoning, creativity, and exploration. By building these foundations, she says children can learn to think independently and succeed in our rapidly changing, technology-driven society.
